Membership Summary – Bill Yucuis

Bill Yucuis shared some background information on the Hillsborough county and neighboring counties AFA membership. Currently our chapter is the second largest in the State of Florida, however, we don't have that many active members at this time.

MacDill AFB:

First Term Airman Course (FTAC) has a monthly graduation where our chapter presents a
Professional Airman Award which includes a pen set and a free 1-year AFA eMembership. This
was restarted in November 2021.

- Airman Leadership Course (ALS) provides an opportunity to speak to students one day during the course about the Air Force Association. This was restarted in December 2021.
- There are various Professional Development opportunities to meet with various base leadership groups, such as Chiefs Group, Top 3, NCO, Airmen, and CGO. We would like to schedule Lunch Briefings, if possible.
- During the Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) graduation, a chapter member presents the Pitsenbarger Award(s).
- Chapter personnel also contact appropriate base individuals about AFA opportunities, such as Spouse Scholarships.

USF AFROTC Support:

- Arnold Air Society (AAS) cadets are also AFA members. Chapter members meet with AAS cadets to talk about AFA opportunities. One example of support to AAS cadets is helping fund travel to RCON and NATCON.
- There are also other opportunities to support by attending unit Awards and Graduation ceremonies, Military Ball in spring and present the Outstanding AFROTC Cadet Award
- Bill Yucuis is seeking to meet Col Montgomery to discuss further details on support for USF AFROTC

AFJROTC Support

- Our chapter also supports 10 AFJROTC units in our area: Durant, Bloomingdale, Middleton, Blake, H.B. Plant, Jefferson, Sickles, River Ridge, Springstead, Hernando
- Our chapter members attend Awards Ceremony and present the AFA National Cadet of Year Award

AFA Education Mission Support

- Stewart Middle School is a NASA Explorer School and has the John Glenn Club (after school space club). Our chapter sometime help selecting John Glenn club candidates. We also support a yearly trip to Kennedy Space Center. Some members have in the past spoken at yearly Teach Ins about AFA and their life experiences.
- There are opportunities to promote and support CyberPatriot and StellarXplorers. There is a current contact at MITRE, who supports Robinson High School StellarXplorers team
- There also is the Chapter Teacher of the Year (TOY) AFA program. Nominations due to AFA NLT April 30. This award is sponsored by Nationals and is at no cost to Chapter. AFA provides \$250 check, TOY pin and certificate, and free CAP Educator membership.
